Mr. Salinas called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M. Members present: Edward Salinas and Wanda Bercegay Andrea Fuentes was absent. Also present: Freida Burgess, superintendent; Kathy White, minutes clerk, and Carolyn Camfield. Also present was Jay Atkins.

Board discussed the selling of 3 lots to the Town of Optima containing a water well. Mr. Atkins was invited to join the discussion.
