## ARP ESSER PLAN Prevention and Mitigation Strategies

Optima Public School will have sanitation stations in every classroom and the cafeteria to remind students to use them frequently. We will also ensure that all bathrooms are stocked regularly with soap and towels for proper hand washing. Staff will be responsible for reinforcing hand washing protocols.

All persons should cover coughs and sneezes with tissue and discard appropriately, then wash or sanitize their hands. Custodial staff will follow a cleaning checklist and perform static fogging regularly. 20% To Address Academic Support

Optima School has added IXL, STAR Fall, Moby Max, Edgenuity and other on line materials to help provide differentiated literacy instruction. These programs provides explicit, systematic, personalized learning in six areas of reading instruction, targeting skill gaps as they emerge, and providing teachers with the data and student-specific resources they need for individual or small group instruction.

Interventions Optima School has access to Panhandle Services to effectively address the social/emotional impact caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

We also provide after school tutoring two days a week for 90 additional minutes of assistance in the academic areas. These services will provide assistance to those students from low-income families, students of color, English language learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, and children in foster care.

Remaining Use of ARP ESSER Funds:
